

Unit 3B Manipulating Sound

In this unit children will explore and develop musical ideas by using ICT and other methods. They will use simple music software, tape recorders and a keyboard to compose, collect and communicate their musical ideas. They will amend and modify their work to explore various musical and sound effects, and use ICT to create, organise and record sounds



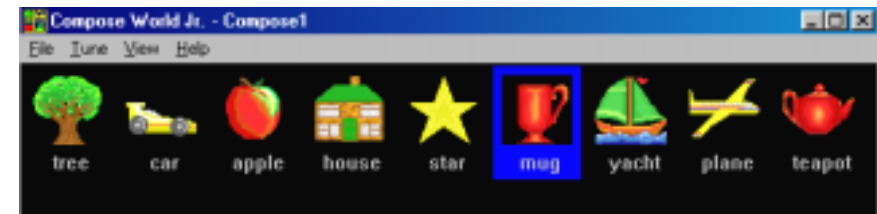
This unit assumes that children:

- * can use ICT to make selections
- * are familiar with graphic representations of music.



Learning Outcomes:

- * recognise that an electronic keyboard can be used to select and control sounds
- * locate and record sound
- * understand how musical phrases can be organised and re-organised using icons
- * recognise some of the differences between live and computer-controlled sounds



Children organise and reorganise sounds by manipulating appropriate icons.
